

GUIDELINES TO THE AUTHORS

Format : Length of the paper should not exceed 10 pages

Submission of manuscript : Paper should be typed with double spacing with font size of 12 in Times New Roman. Margin on all sides of paper should be 1.5 inches

Title : make the title specific enough to describe the contents of the paper. The title should be appropriate for the intended audience.

Authors : The person who did the work and wrote the paper is generally listed as the first author of a research paper. For published articles other people who made significant contributions to the work are also listed as authors. Mentors permission should be taken before including her /his name as co-author.

Abstract : An abstract or summary is published together with the research article giving the reader a 'preview' of what is to come. Your abstract should be one paragraph of 100-250 words which summarizes the purpose, methods, results and conclusions of the paper. Do not use abbreviations or citations in the abstract. It should be self explanatory.

Introduction : It should be concise with what has been done and why the subject has been chosen with brief background. Review of literature should be brief, pertinent and up to date.

Material and methods : It should be briefly described. You can use diagrams, table or flow chart for better understanding. Mention relevant ethical considerations.

Results : Use graphs and tables if appropriate. Summarize your main findings in the text.

References : Follow Vancouver style. All references should be checked minutely for their appearance in text as well as in reference/bibliography sections.

Table and illustrations : Tables should be given in separate pages with due reference in the text

Peer review : All papers submitted will undergo a double blind peer review process. On the basis of response from the peer review paper will either be rejected or accepted subject to major or minor revisions or accepted unconditionally.

Originality of the article : Author should make sure before submitting that the same article is not published in any form before and after.
