- ➤ Based on the preferences given, the seats will be allotted on merit and the allotment which is displayed on website of State CET Cell http://www.mahacet.org.
- Admission to BSc Nursing course is subject to the grant of eligibility by MUHS, Nashik.
- ➤ 15% NRI/ Vacant NRI scats shall be filled by the eligible candidates including NRI Candidates who have appeared and qualified in MH-BSc Nursing-CET 2023. These seats will be filled by the institute by calling application(s) at the institute from all eligible candidates.
- ➤ Candidate seeking admission at the college shall join the college as per procedure of State CET Cell. In case she does not join the college, she will not be eligible for subsequent admission process of MH-BSc Nursing-CET 2023.
- > The candidate has to fulfil qualifications and eligibility criteria as mentioned in rules published by government from time to time.
